

Revised Center of G-6 Papa's Star

Cut:

1. Background

Four 1-1/4 inch squares for corners

Four 1 X 1-1/4 inch rectangles for star points

2. Print

Eight 3/4 inch squares for star points

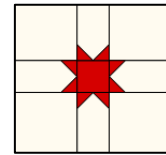
One 1 inch square for center of star

Assemble

- Prepare star points by folding print squares along the diagonal, press
- Make four flying geese by placing the folded squares along the narrow edge



- Baste through all thicknesses along the sides and bottom, with 1/8 inch seam allowance



- Sew little star together, leaving the excess fabric around it
- Draw the pentagon on freezer paper and cut it out
- Fold it in half lengthwise and line it up with the center of the star
- Press freezer paper to the front of star piece
- Trim, leaving 1/4 inch seam allowance **outside** the freezer paper
